

# Consent to processing of personal data

- 1.1. This document governs relationships between the person who processes personal data and the person who provides his personal data for processing.
- 1.2. A participant of the event (hereinafter **“the Participant”**), by registering for this event posted at <http://digitaloctober.com/> (hereinafter **“the Event”**), undertakes to accept the Consent to processing of personal data (hereinafter **“the Consent”**).
- 1.3. The acceptance of the offer of this Consent shall be registration of the Participant for the Event, i.e. actions required to perform the terms of the contract stated in the offer (Clause 3 of Article 434 and Clause 3 of Article 438 of the Civil Code).
- 1.4. The Participant consents to processing of his personal data by the organizer of this Event, Digital October Limited Liability Company (hereinafter **“the Organizer”**), located at Moscow, Bersenevskaya embankment, 6, bldg. 3, on the following terms:
  - 1.4.1. The consent shall be granted to processing of personal data with or without automation facilities.
  - 1.4.2. The consent shall be granted to processing of the following personal data:**
    - 1.4.2.1. Full name;
    - 1.4.2.2. Contact telephone numbers;
    - 1.4.2.3. E-mail address;
    - 1.4.2.4. Place of employment and position;
    - 1.4.2.5. Details of education, further training and career development;
  - 1.4.3. Personal data is not attributed to be generally accessible.
  - 1.4.4. The purpose of processing of personal data is registration of the Participant for the Event, advertising campaigns and marketing research, acquiring of other statistical data, notification of the Participant of news and other Events by the Organizer, provision of information by third parties to which the Organizer communicated the personal data in accordance with this Consent.
  - 1.4.5. The legal basis for processing of personal data is Article 24 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation; Article 6 of Federal Law No. 152-FZ “On Personal Data”; other federal laws and regulatory documents.
  - 1.4.6. Processing of personal data includes the following processes: collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification (updating, modification), extraction, use, transfer (distribution, provision, access), anonymization, blocking, deletion, destruction.
  - 1.4.7. The Organizer shall be entitled to process the Participant’s personal data by entering them into electronic databases, including them in lists (registers) and other reporting forms.
  - 1.4.8. The Participant consents to exchange (receipt, transfer) of personal data between the Organizer and third parties in accordance with contracts and agreements entered into by the Organizer for the purposes of Clause 1.4.4. of this Consent and to observe the legal rights and interests of the Participant. Such exchange (receipt, transfer) shall be performed without further notification of the Participant.
  - 1.4.9. The Participant consents to communication of its personal data to the competent state authorities and federal agencies of the Russian Federation at the relevant written request of such authorities and agencies. Such exchange (receipt, transfer) shall be performed without further notification of the Participant.
  - 1.4.10. Personal data shall be processed within the term of the Organizer’s activities. Personal data shall be stored in accordance with Federal Law No. 125-FZ “On Archiving in the Russian Federation” and other regulatory documents related to archiving and archival storage.
- 1.5. This Consent may be withdrawn by the Participant by sending a written request to the Organizer’s representative to [do@digitaloctober.com](mailto:do@digitaloctober.com).
- 1.6. If the Participant withdraws his consent to processing of his personal data, the Organizer shall be entitled to continue processing his personal data without the User’s consent on the grounds indicated in Clauses 2-11 of part 1 of Article 6, part 2 of Article 10 and part 2 of Article 11 of Federal Law No. 152-FZ “On Personal Data” dated July 27, 2006.
- 1.7. This Consent shall be valid at all times until the processing of personal data indicated in Clauses 1.4.10. and 1.5. of this Consent is discontinued.
